BYLAW NO. 06/17

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF TISDALE TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 17/11 KNOWN AS THE TRAFFIC BYLAW

The Council of the Town of Tisdale, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in open meeting enacts as follows:

Bylaw No. 17/11 is amended as follows:

1. Section 3. Interpretation, Subsection a) 43) shall be replaced with the following:

43) "Trailer" shall mean a trailer or semi-trailer designed to be attached to a vehicle.

2. Section 5. Infractions, Restrictions and Prohibitions, Subsection e) 7) shall be replaced with the following:

e) Parking

7) 48 Hour Limit:

No person shall park a vehicle or trailer continuously on any highway or parking lot of the Town or municipally owned property for a period exceeding 48 hours.

3. Section 5. Infractions, Restrictions and Prohibitions, Subsection e) 13) shall be deleted in its entirety.

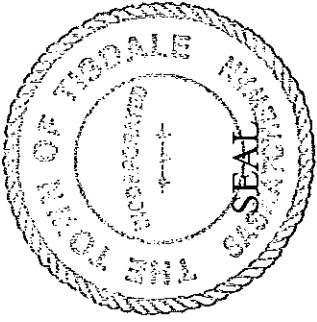
4. Section 5. Infractions, Restrictions and Prohibitions, Subsection e) 14) shall be replaced with the following:

e) Parking

14) Parking of Unlicensed Vehicles:


No motor vehicle or trailer shall be parked on a highway unless it is displaying a valid license plate or a valid permit.

5. Section 14. Penalties, Subsection a) 12) shall be deleted in its entirety.
6. This Bylaw shall come into force on the date of final approval by Council.
